



NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION and DURHAM COUNTY REFERENDA November 8, 2011

Municipal Election for the City of Durham Mayor and Durham City Council - At Large will be held in Durham County, NC on Tuesday November 8th. All Durham County precincts will be open from 6:30am until 7:30pm.

The following races and referenda will be on the City of Durham ballots:

- City of Durham Mayor
- Durham City Council – At Large (3 seats)
- Durham County Referenda listed below

The following Referenda will be on all Durham County ballots:

- County Sales and Use Tax – Local sales and use tax at the rate of one-quarter percent (0.25%) in addition to all other State and local sales and use taxes.
- County Public Transportation Sales and Use Tax – One-half percent (1/2%) local sales and use taxes, in addition to the current local sales and use taxes, to be used only for public transportation systems.

The following contest and referenda will be on the ballot for all eligible voters in the proposed Town of Rougemont area:

- Incorporation of the Town of Rougemont. (Referendum to be voted For or Against)
- Rougemont Town Council (5 seats) Valid only if Incorporation Referendum passes.
- County Sales and Use Tax – Local sales and use tax at the rate of one-quarter percent (0.25%) in addition to all other State and local sales and use taxes.
- County Public Transportation Sales and Use Tax – One-half percent (1/2%) local sales and use taxes, in addition to the current local sales and use taxes, to be used only for public transportation systems.

SAME DAY REGISTRATION: Voters are now allowed to **register and vote** at a One Stop site. It is quicker and easier to register in advance, but if you have not registered you can do so during One Stop voting with proper identification. **This same day registration is not allowed at the precincts on Election Day.**

All registered voters residing in the County of Durham are eligible and encouraged to vote in this election. Voters who are currently registered need not re-register. Registered voters who have moved or changed other information since the last election should notify the Board of Elections of that change by Friday, October 14, 2011 at 5:00 pm.
